Bible Point:

God hears our prayers.

"So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today" (Matthew 6:34).

- Write Matthew 7:7 on a piece of paper: "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you."
- As a family, decorate the sign.
- Hang it on the door your family uses most often to exit the house.
- Whenever you see it, let it be a reminder to pray—even if it's a really quick prayer as you rush out the door!
